

NEW POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- **Campsite Deposits:** To renew your campsite for the 2019 season, you must pay a deposit of \$200.00 by December 31, 2018. If the deposit is not paid by this date, a campsite agreement will not be mailed to you, and your site will be considered open and available. This \$200.00 will be applied to your 2019 seasonal campsite fee. If you decide not to renew your campsite for the 2019 season, it must be removed from the site by April 30, 2019. This will allow for us to fill open sites before the new season begins.
- **Dock transfers:** Anytime throughout the season, if you wish to transfer to a different dock than the one that has been assigned to you per the 2018-19 Seasonal Boat Slip Agreement, you must fill out a Dock Transfer Request Form at the Marina Office. This form must be approved by the appropriate official, and a fee of \$25.00 will be assessed to complete the transfer.
- **Boat Winter Storage:** In the past, the boat winter storage agreement was included as part of the seasonal boat slip agreement. These agreements have been separated. The winter storage fee can be paid at any time throughout the season, but must be paid in full before your boat can be placed in winter storage.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Docks and Campsites are NON-TRANSFERABLE, a dock and/or campsite does not get transferred to a new owner with the sale of a boat or camper. If a camper or boat is sold, the contract for the campsite or dock is null, and therefore the camper or boat must be removed from that spot immediately.
- Excessive loud noise shall be prohibited. Evening curfew shall be in effect between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- Fireworks (legal or otherwise) and Chinese Lanterns are absolutely PROHIBITED. If anyone is found to be in violation of this, law enforcement will be involved.
- All construction, including sheds, decks, platforms, etc., must be approved by the Code Enforcement Officer, or the Marina Trustee. Applications for such construction are available at the Marina Office.
- Dock deposits are due by December 31, 2018, if your deposit is not received on or before this date, your dock will be considered open and available for the 2019 season.
